Registration

Registration Fees

A valid Canada Snowboard provincial membership is required to register (ie. Nova Scotia Snowboard Membership). All GROM series participants must have a recreation level membership or above. All Provincial series participants must have a competitive membership.

Provincial Series fee is \$30.00

GROM competition fee is \$10.00.

All participants must have a valid Martock lift ticket or season pass in order to participate in events.

INSURANCE, LIABILITY, RULES & SANCTIONING

All NSSBD events follow Canada Snowboard Event Guidelines, and the [FIS ICR Rules](#) apply

These events are insured and sanctioned by Canada Snowboard. All participants must sign an event waiver before participating in any events.

All NSSBD events follow Canada Snowboard Helmet Policy which includes mandatory helmet use in all areas including start/finish areas for all attending including athletes, coaches and spectators.

EVENT DETAILS & SCHEDULE

A snowboard Giant Slalom (GS) race is a technical alpine event where riders race down a course with widely spaced gates (20-25m), requiring a blend of speed, control, and carving technique.

Provincial Series athletes get three runs, with their two fastest times combined for their final time. The winner is the rider with the fastest combined time.

GROM Series athletes also get three runs, but only their fastest time counts. This provides for more opportunity to practice and refine each run to progress throughout the event for younger athletes.
