Excellence Coach Report – Kristin d'Eon

- It is with great sadness that I will not be returning to NS SBD for the 2021-22 season. I have been accepted into the Halifax Police, 2022 Police Science Program.
- Working with NS Snowboard over the past 10 years allowed me to be part of many significant accomplishments, including:
 - Advanced Coaching Diploma Graduate 2019
 - Coaching at 9 Canadian Nationals
 - Coached two athletes who were selected to represent Canada at the 2020 Youth Olympic Games
 - Coached the 2015 Canada Winter Games with NS Snowboard athletes bringing home two medals
 - Multiple podium/top 4 finishes at FIS/Jr. Nationals/NorAm Events
 - Liam Moffatt making the Canada Snowboard NextGen Team and earning a top 8 at the 2021 World Championships
 - NS Snowboard being classified as a Tier 1 Excellence sport recognized by Sport Nova Scotia, the Provincial Government & the Canadian Sport Centre Atlantic
- I want to thank everyone involved with this process, athletes, other coaches, board members, but I want to specifically mention Deb MacLean who was the president/board member for the majority of my time. I truly feel that without her guidance I would not have been able to become the best version of myself.

Provincial Team Accomplishments

- What can I say other than Covid...
- It was a tough year because of covid, and it was made tougher with the warmer weather and travel restrictions keeping us in NS.
- We added two new race coaches to help round out the coaching staff to athlete ratio.
- Both Freestyle and Race added new riders bringing our total number of athletes to 28!

Traveling Athlete Highlights

- Covid kept NS SBD in the province this season but we did have one athlete who was able to travel because they are part of the National team.
- Liam Moffatt had an amazing season with 5 World cup starts. His best finish was 8th at World Championships in Sweden! Liam is well on his way to earning a spot on the National team and possibly the 2022 Olympics.

NS Snowboard Coaching

- Post - Season debriefs have been completed with Head Coaches and the majority of the coaching staff.
- Majority of coaches are returning for the 2021-22 season.
- Planning (Trips, Comps & Training) for the next season will begin shortly with new Excellence Coach.

EXCELLENCE COACH REPORT – CASSANDRA SMITH

AUGUST 2021 -OCTOBER 2021

- While I have only been in the role for a short while, it has been a busy time, with both learning the role and starting athlete training.
- Zach has done a great job in making sure that fall activities were ready to run for the over all Nova Scotia Snowboard team aspect as well as for individual programs. Kim has also been keeping the development program running.
- Since the start of the fall we have had 2 days at the dryslope at Martock, 3 trampoline sessions and a team wide hike to Cape Split. We have also had regular strength and conditioning training at the Canadian Sport Center Atlantic (CSCA) and the satellite option at Acadia University.

EXCELLENCE COACH REPORT – CASSANDRA SMITH

AUGUST 2021-OCTOBER 2021

- Upcoming in the next month we are continuing with the dryslope training and trampoline for all club, and the CSCA strength and conditioning training for qualified senior athletes. We will also be adding airbag training for the athletes We expect to start seeing athlete on snow by mid to late November with planning underway for training camp options.
- On Friday October 8th we did an all-teams registration form mail out – as of 8 am October 12th we have 10 athletes registered. These registration forms are important as they will be used to confirm acceptance into the provincial programs, as well as collect important information for general contact and the emergency action plans for the coaches, we encourage everyone to complete these as soon as possible. If you haven't received the google form request, please email cassandra@snowboardnovascotia.ca (it is possible that emails on file are wrong) and check junk mails.
- Fall is a busy time for the coaches with individual meetings and small group meetings happening – all last years coaches have agreed to continue to be part of the programs and we are excited to be kicking off the planning processes. Our goal is to have planned calendars that are published for parents by November 1st around not just events but also quality training volumes.
- This month I have also had several meetings, connecting with the many stakeholders involved in the programs – they are guiding me through a number of items so that this winter and the next few winters will see sustained success with the snowboard programs in all disciplines and support for the athletes (and families) that choose the high-performance pathway. There have also been discussions in further support for grass-roots levels of snowboarding and increased inclusion within our capacity. I look forward to all the amazing things that Nova Scotia Snowboard is going to do in the next few years and the amazing athletes that all of the coaches get to work with!


