## **NS SBD Slopestyle at Ben Eoin**

---

The NS Snowboard Slopestyle at Ben Eoin will be 1 of 3 Slopestyle events held as part of NS Snowboard's Provincial Series in the 2021-22 season. This event brings together competitive NS Snowboard and other PTSA athletes to compete in a day of competitive freestyle competition.

The entire NS Snowboard team would like to welcome all athletes and look forward to hosting a competitive, fun, and safe environment that allows the athletes to excel and progress.

## **THE RESORT**

---

Ski Ben Eoin is in Ben Eoin, Nova Scotia. 25 min from Sydney, NS in Cape Breton. Ben Eoin has eleven trails including a terrain park, beginner area, a quad chairlift, and a magic carpet, with multiple trails lit for night riding.

## **FORMAT**

---

### **Provincial Series**

- Best 1 of 3 runs – Main Park

### **GROM**

- Best 1 of 3 runs – Upper Park (*Beginner section – Exact Features TBD closer to the event date*)

### **Judges will be using the Overall Impression System.**

*Each Judge shall score the run by evaluating it from start to finish from an overall perspective, using the criteria described in the Judges' Handbook. Three to seven judges shall independently evaluate the competitor's performance based upon the judging criteria. Judges take falls, mistakes and stops into consideration and can deduct points of the run/judge for each fall/stop. Each Judge shall give a score out of 1-100 to each competitor, without the use of decimals. Wherever the competitor's score is derived from a calculation involving division, the result shall be truncated (rounded down) and shown to two decimal places.*

## **SANCTION**

---

The competitions are sanctioned by Canada Snowboard and NS Snowboard. Certified helmets are mandatory for all training and competitions (FIS ICR Rule 2010.6), for both competitors and coaches (Nova Scotia Law). Competitions are run in accordance with the provincial rules.

## **RULES & REGULATIONS**

---

Certified helmets are mandatory for everyone on Skis or Snowboards in Nova Scotia. Failure to do so could result in a \$250 fine and will result in removal from the competition.

## **REFUND POLICY**

---

Event Registration Fee refunds require the approval Nova Scotia Snowboard Executive Director.

The following are viable reasons for permitting Event Registration Fee refunds:

- Event cancellation or date/location changes
- Injury sustained prior to event training, preventing participation in event – must be confirmed with doctor's note.
- Exceptions: hardship special circumstances require the prior approval of Nova Scotia Snowboard Executive Director

Refunds for cash or cheque transactions must be refunded by cheque.

Credit card refunds must be processed via card transaction credit.

Lift Tickets are not refundable.
