NS SBD FIS at Martock

The NS Snowboard FIS Snowboard Cross events at Martock will be the only FIS events held by NS Snowboard this season, and 1 of 2 FIS Snowboard Cross events hosted in Atlantic Canada during the 2021-22 season. This event brings together competitive NS Snowboard and other PTSA athletes to compete in two days of competitive Snowboard Cross racing.

The entire NS Snowboard team would like to welcome regional visiting athletes and look forward to hosting a competitive, fun, and safe environment that allows the athletes to excel and progress.

THE RESORT

Ski Martock is in Windsor, Nova Scotia. 50 min from the Halifax International Airport and one hour from downtown Halifax. Martock has seven trails including a terrain park, riglet park, beginner bowl, a quad chairlift, a t-bar lift, and a magic carpet, all with lighting for night riding. Martock hosted all the snowboard events for the 2011 Canada Winter Games in Halifax and hosted FIS SBX events in 2017 & 2020.

CANADIAN COACHES REGISTRATION

All Canadian coaches at events must register and meet the Canadian Minimum Coach Certification Standards.

REFUND POLICY

Event Registration Fee refunds require the approval of the Nova Scotia Snowboard Executive Director.

Request for refund must be submitted by email to: alpinens@sportnovascotia.ca

The following are viable reasons for permitting Event Registration Fee refunds:

- Event cancellation or date/location changes
- Injury sustained prior to event training, preventing participation in the event – must be confirmed with a doctor's note.
- Exceptions: hardship special circumstances require the prior approval of the Nova Scotia Snowboard Executive Director

Refunds for cash or cheque transactions must be refunded by cheque.

Credit card refunds must be processed via card transaction credit.

Lift Tickets are not refundable.

SANCTION

The competitions are sanctioned by the FIS, Canada Snowboard and NS Snowboard.

Certified helmets are mandatory for all training and competitions (FIS ICR Rule 2010.6), for both competitors and coaches (Nova Scotia Law). Competitions are run in accordance with the FIS ICR rules. Every athlete **MUST** be represented by a Team Captain (Coach) at the TC meeting.

RULES & REGULATIONS

Certified helmets are mandatory for everyone on Skis or Snowboards in Nova Scotia. Failure to do so could result in a \$250 fine and will result in removal from the competition.
