The NS Snowboard Slopestyle Provincials at Martock will be 1 of 4 Slopestyle events held as part of NS Snowboard's Provincial Series in the 2021-22 season. This event brings together competitive NS Snowboard and other PTSA athletes to compete in a day of competitive freestyle competition to crown a provincial champion.

The entire NS Snowboard team would like to welcome all athletes and look forward to hosting a competitive, fun, and safe environment that allows the athletes to excel and progress.

THE RESORT

Ski Martock is in Windsor, Nova Scotia. 50 min from the Halifax International Airport and one hour from downtown Halifax. Martock has seven trails including a terrain park, riglet park, beginner bowl, a quad chairlift, a t-bar lift, and a magic carpet, all with lighting for night riding. Martock hosted all the snowboard events for the 2011 Canada Winter Games in Halifax.

SANCTION

The competitions are sanctioned by Canada Snowboard and NS Snowboard.

Certified helmets are mandatory for all training and competitions (FIS ICR Rule 2010.6), for both competitors and coaches (Nova Scotia Law). Competitions are run in accordance with the FIS rules.

RULES & REGULATIONS

Certified helmets are mandatory for everyone on Skis or Snowboards in Nova Scotia. Failure to do so could result in a \$250 fine and will result in removal from the competition.

REFUND POLICY

Event Registration Fee refunds require the approval Nova Scotia Snowboard Executive Director.

Request for refund must be submitted by email to: alpinens@sportnovascotia.ca

The following are viable reasons for permitting Event Registration Fee refunds:

- Event cancellation or date/location changes
- Injury sustained prior to event training, preventing participation in event – must be confirmed with doctor’s note.
- Exceptions: hardship special circumstances require the prior approval of Nova Scotia Snowboard Executive Director

Refunds for cash or cheque transactions must be refunded by cheque.

Credit card refunds must be processed via card transaction credit.

Lift Tickets are not refundable.
