* ALL athletes MUST be represented by a Canada Snowboard licensed coach - Athletes without a coach will be provided a coach by NSSBD

- Canada Snowboard Helmet Policy include mandatory helmet use in all areas including Start/Finish areas

EVENT DETAILS & SCHEDULE

A Snowboard Cross (SBX) race is a high-speed racing discipline where up to four snowboarders race simultaneously down a narrow, technical course. Featuring jumps, banked turns, rollers, and drops, riders compete to cross the finish line first while navigating incidental contact.

Event Format - Race to qualify- athletes will race in categories multiple times for gate choice in finals - first across the line wins! This means more races for everyone.

Certified helmets are mandatory for all training and competitions.

REFUND POLICY

- Event cancellation or date/location changes
- Injury sustained prior to event training, preventing participation in the event – must be confirmed with a doctor's note.
- Exceptions: hardship special circumstances require the prior approval of Nova Scotia Snowboard's Board of Directors.
