All Provincial Series participants must register for a NS Snowboard Compete or above Membership through Canada Snowboard to participate in NS Snowboard events.

All GROM Series participants must have a Recreation Membership through Canada Snowboard

## EVENT DETAILS & SCHEDULE

---

A Rail Jam is a freestyle snowboard competition where athletes come together to throw down their best tricks. The rail jam includes rails and boxes, but no jumps.

There is no minimum or maximum number of runs, participants drop as few or many times as they want within a time limit. The event does have a controlled start - and all riders must receive permission from the Chief of Start before dropping into the course or their run will not count. Any athletes who drop for a run without permission will be given a verbal warning by the Chief of Start. If an athlete drops a second time without permission they will be disqualified.

The Rail Jam will take place in the Terrain Park. There will be a single deck of features included with a minimum of 3 rail options from M to XL.

The GROM Divisions will also take place in the Terrain Park on a smaller set of features. This will also include a minimum of 2 features, with a variety of options from small beginner boxes up to beginner rails.

Awards will be available for the Top 3 Riders based on Overall Impression in each Division. A full ranking will not be provided for a Rail Jam event.

The following are viable reasons for permitting Event Registration Fee refunds:

- Event cancellation or date/location changes
- Injury sustained prior to event training, preventing participation in event – must be confirmed with doctor's note.
- Exceptions: hardship special circumstances require the prior approval of Nova Scotia Snowboard's Board of Directors.

Lift Tickets are not refundable.
