All GROM Series participants must have a Recreation Membership through Canada Snowboard

* ALL athletes MUST be represented by a Canada Snowboard licensed coach - Athletes without a coach will be provided a coach by NSSBD

- All NSSBD Events follow Canada Snowboard Event Guidelines, and the [FIS ICR Rules](#) apply
- Canada Snowboard Helmet Policy include mandatory helmet use in all areas including Start/Finish areas

EVENT DETAILS & SCHEDULE

A snowboard Giant Slalom (GS) race is a technical alpine event where riders race down a course with widely spaced gates (20-24m), requiring a blend of speed, control, and carving technique.

Provincial Series athletes get three runs, with their two fastest times combined for their final time. The winner is the rider with the fastest combined time.

GROM Series athletes also get three runs, but only their fastest time counts. This provides for more opportunity to practice and refine each run to progress throughout the event for younger athletes.

INSURANCE & LIABILITY

The events are insured and sanctioned by Canada Snowboard. All participants must sign an Event Waiver before participating in any events.

Certified helmets are mandatory for all training and competitions.

REFUND POLICY

Event Registration Fee refunds require the approval of Nova Scotia Snowboard's Board of Directors.

The following are viable reasons for permitting Event Registration Fee refunds:

- Event cancellation or date/location changes
- Injury sustained prior to event training, preventing participation in the event – must be confirmed with a doctor's note.
- Exceptions: hardship special circumstances require the prior approval of Nova Scotia Snowboard's Board of Directors.

Lift Tickets are not refundable.
